I am very happy to present before you the excellent performance report of the Academic Year 2018-19. This year was vibrant with diverse programmes and activities that developed the mind and heart of the students. Because of the time constraint I will be touching upon only the outstanding achievements.

The school has 345 students at present. Our Sixth batch of 20 students appeared for Class X Board Exam this year and brought glorious result with 100% pass. The school has 100% pass for the Sixth consecutive year. This year, out of 20 students, 2 students got full A1. Aparna P Nair secured All India 6th rank in CBSE Board Examination by scoring 493/500. She got full marks in Maths and Social Sciece. Neha Mariet Sojan also got A1 in all subjects. 3 students got overall A1 and 6 students got overall A. They are Lija George, Annu Maria Raju, Anchela Treesa Sunny, Tony Philip, Joel Joshy, Manuel Shaji, Deepa Maria Thankachen, Keziah Theresa Shaji and Ann Litta Joe . Taking into consideration the new examination and evaluation pattern of the CBSE, this is a very creditable achievement.

The Management of the school

The school is managed by Mary Matha Educational and Charitable Trust. Rev. Fr. Joseph Thadathil is the president of the Trust and manager of the school. Rev. Fr. Thomas Manalel is the Asst. Manager. The members of the Trust are Shri. Dheeraj Zacharias Cheruthodukayil (Secretary cum Treasurer), Shri. Roy Joseph, Shri. Sunil Karickal, Shri. Biju Simon Pallathukuzhy, and Shri. Sunny Cherian Kadiyamkuttiyil. I gratefully acknowledge the service they render to the growth of the school. This year we purchased new furniture for the KG section and have made it child-friendly and modern with audio visual equipment. School Management committee meet periodically and assess the progress of the school academically and infrastructure wise.

The Faculty

The school has a team of 21 well qualified, experienced and dedicated teachers. They are the backbone of the school. The co-operation and dedication of our staff, both teaching and non-teaching, is worth mentioning. Nine supporting staff are also working in this school taking care of the various needs of our children. Moral and religious instruction classes are conducted with all seriousness.

Co-Curricular Activities

Adhering to the goal of the school "in Pursuit of Excellence" the school imparts training for allround personality development of students. Every student has to take part in at least one of the following co-curricular activities - Karate, yoga, Abacus, Painting and Dance

Apart from the co-curricular activities many extra-curricular activities and clubs function in the school. The Eco Club, Creative Writing Club, Maths Club, Public Speaking Club, Quiz Club, Science Club, and Spoken English Club function effectively in the school. Various programmes are conducted to develop the organizational and event management skills of the pupils. Celebrations like Teachers' Day, Children's Day, Environmental Day, Onam, Christmas etc are event managed by students. Periodic meetings are held to improve the histrionic talents of the students.
